Cutting Instructions:

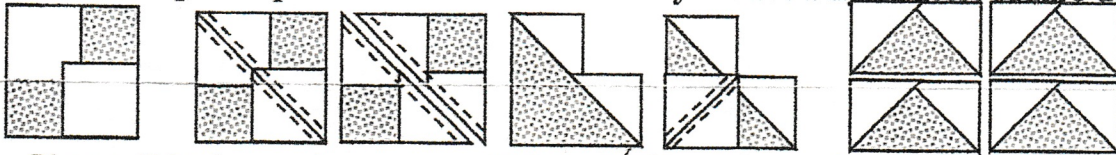
Background: cut 4 squares $4\frac{1}{4}'' \times 4\frac{1}{4}''$ for flying geese unit. Cut 4 squares $4'' \times 4''$ for half square triangles (HST). Draw a line on the wrong side of all these.

Color A: cut 1 square $7\frac{3}{4}''$ for flying geese.

Color B: cut 2 squares $4'' \times 4''$ for HST

Color C: cut 2 squares $4'' \times 4''$ HST

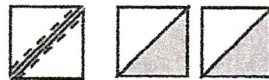
1. Place 2 of the background $4\frac{1}{4}''$ squares on opposite corners of the $7\frac{3}{4}''$ Color A square right sides together. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the background triangles; you will get 2 units. Place another $4\frac{1}{4}''$ background square on the corner of the large triangle; stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the background triangles. Repeat with the other triangle unit. You will get 4 finished flying geese units. **Square up to measure $3\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$. Do you have a flying geese square-up ruler?**



2. Place a $4''$ background square on a $4''$ Color B right sides together. Stitch on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line, press toward the dark. Repeat to get a total of 4 half square triangle units. **Square up each to $3\frac{1}{2}''$. Use Bloc-Loc or Tucker Trimmer if you have one.**



3. Place a $4''$ background square on a $4''$ Color C right sides together. Stitch on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line, press toward the dark. Repeat to get a total of 4 half square triangle units. **Square up each to $3\frac{1}{2}''$**



4. Sew a Color B and a Color C HST together as shown. Repeat to make 4.



5. Sew the Step 4 unit to a flying geese unit as shown. Make 4. Sew these 4 together to make a block that measures $12\frac{1}{2}'' \times 12\frac{1}{2}''$.
