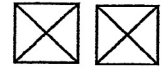
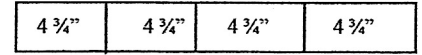


PATTERN #8-April - Centennial Star

Fabric Key #1 = background, #2 = medium, #3= dark

Cutting instructions :

1. Cut 1 square $7\frac{1}{4}''$ and 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}''$ background fabric. Subcut the $7\frac{1}{4}''$ square twice diagonally as shown to get 4 triangles.
2. Cut 1 strip $2\frac{5}{8}''$ of medium fabric. Subcut into four lengths $4\frac{3}{4}''$.
3. Cut 1 square $4\frac{3}{4}''$ and 2 squares $4\frac{1}{4}''$ of dark fabric. Subcut the $4\frac{1}{4}''$ squares twice diagonally as shown to get 8 triangles.



Piecing instructions:

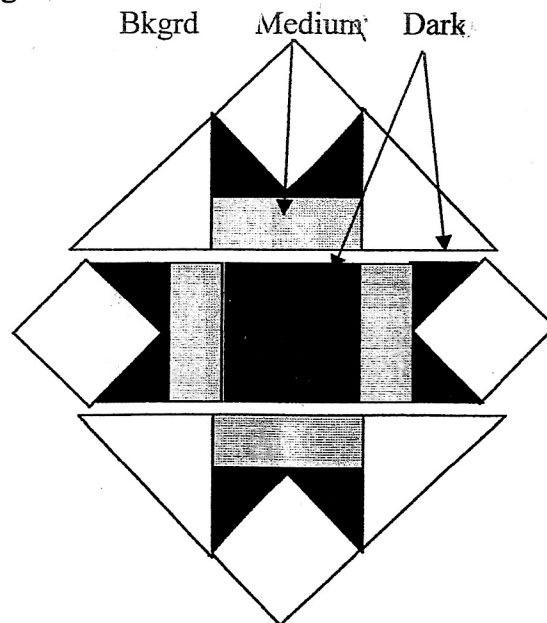
1. Stitch 2 dark triangles on adjacent sides of the $3\frac{1}{2}''$ background square matching the center of the block and triangle. (#1). Press to the dark triangles. Make 4 of these units. Stitch these units to the $4\frac{3}{4}''$ medium rectangle (#2) matching the center of the rectangle to the center point. Press to the medium rectangle. Stitch the large background triangles to opposite sides of two of the units (#3). Press to the background triangle.



2. Stitch two of the above units (#2) to opposite sides of the center dark $4\frac{3}{4}''$ square. Press towards the center square.



3. Stitch the remaining side units (#3) to the opposite sides of the block, matching the intersecting seams. Press to the center unit again.
