Regina York, Morning President opened the meeting with a reminder on how to use black/white photo on your fabric choices to see the contrasts for your pattern. The evening people asked that we include this tip in the newsletter:

Make a black and white photocopy of a quilt pattern to easily see the placement of lights, mediums, and darks. Along the side of the photocopy, list the yardage for each fabric and draw an arrow to each fabric's location in the photo. Take the photocopy with you when you buy fabrics. It's easy to adapt or change fabrics when you are looking at the value & tone instead of colorful fabrics.
