PATTERN #9 May - Kansas Dugout Star

Fabric Key #1 = background, #2 = medium, #3= dark

Cutting instructions:

- 1. Cut 1 square 7 ¼", 4 squares 3 ½" and 8 small squares 1 ¾" of background fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 ¾" background squares.
- 2. Cut 4 squares 4" of medium fabric. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of these squares.
- 3. Cut 4 squares 3 ½" of dark fabric.

Piecing instructions:

1. Place the background 1 ¾" squares right sides together on the corner of the dark 3 ½" square. Stitch on the line, cut to ¼" as shown and press to the corner. Repeat on the opposite side of the dark block. Repeat this procedure 3 more times. Stitch the four blocks together for the center of the star.







2. A) Place two of the medium 4" squares on opposite corners of the 7 1/4" background square right sides together. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. (B) Cut on the drawn line. (C) Press to the medium triangles. You will get 2 units. (D) Place another 4" medium square on the corner of the large triangle. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line again. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the triangles. Repeat with the other large triangle unit. You will get 4 finished flying

geese units. Trim geese units to 6 ½" x 3 ½". (A)











3. Stitch 2 of the 3 ½" background squares on the two ends of two of the star point units. Press to the background squares.

4. Assemble in rows as diagrammed.

5. Press side star point units towards the center of the block. Then press the top and bottom rows to the

center unit.
