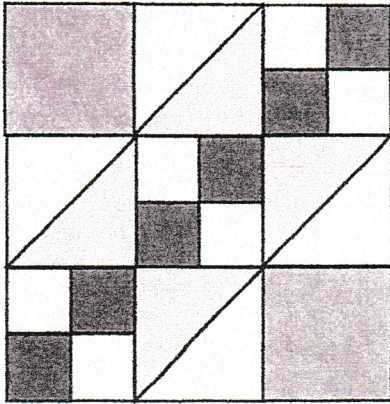

Cutting Instructions: Measure twice, cut once!

Background fabric: Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" and 6 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of the 5" squares.

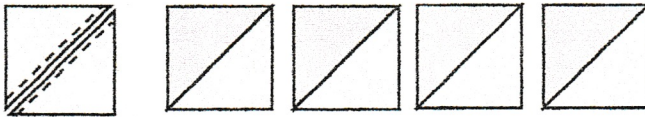
Medium fabric: Cut 2 squares 5" x 5" (for half-square triangles).

Dark fabric: Cut 6 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

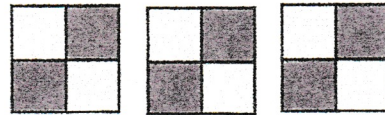
Accent fabric: Cut 2 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Piecing Instructions:

1. Place a background 5" squares on top of the medium 5" square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Repeat. Press toward the medium triangle to get a total of 4 half square triangle units. Trim squares to 4 1/2". Use Tucker Trimmer® or Bloc-Loc®.



2. Stitch the background 2 1/2" squares and the dark 2 1/2" squares together into a 4-patch. Make three 4-patch units. They should measure 4 1/2" square.



3. Stitch the block together into 3 rows as shown with accent corner squares. Press. Block should measure 12 1/2".
