**Opportunity Quilt:** Regina York and Nancy Hart-Kline are taking the quilt to the Farmers Market in Louisburg this Saturday morning.

**KCRQF:** The members met in July to discuss how the money would be divided. It was decided that a 60/40 split would provide every guild with some money but the rest will be determined by guild hours worked. Next month they will decide if the executive board time will be considered for that.

They also discussed each guild choosing a quilter to be featured at the show. In the AM, Nancy Hart-Kline moved and Diane Burnett seconded that Miami County participate in this. In the PM, Cindy Toburen moved and Ellie Owens seconded that Miami County participate in this. Membership agreed. The candidate should be an active member. There was discussion about how to determine the quilter.

The intent is to have all 17 guilds participate. A space will be provided and the quilter will decide what quilts they want to display. The quilts will not be judged so there is not a time limit on when these quilts were made for the quilts used.

If on Facebook, members were encouraged to follow it and like it. The information out there will help advertise the festival. You could type "I really like that quilt and hope I get a chance to see it in June at the KCQRF."

A volunteer will be needed to organize the displaying of the Miami County Quilts.

**MCQG show:** Janna Renner reminded membership that boutique items should be handmade, priced, and include initials plus the month and day of birth. Please get these entries turned in by the evening meeting of the September meeting.

Silent action should be wall hangings and miniatures, baby quilts or smaller. No sleeve is needed if it is 25 inches or smaller. Bring these to the September meeting – as we will be voting on them.
